THE TOWN HALL MEETING IS HELD. IT WAS QUITE THE TURNOUT...

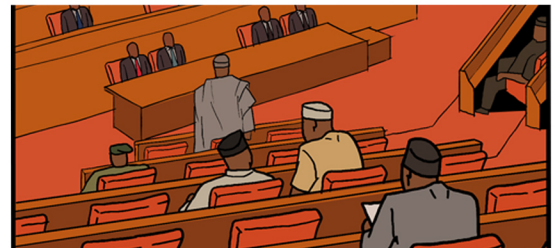
